- 7) Do you plan for the wolf dog to live full-time outdoors, or do you plan to allow it to share your home?
- 8) What type of containment do you have or are you planning to have? Please describe square footage, type of fencing, electric wire, etc.
- 9) In what ways have you researched wolves and wolf dogs? Include books read, Internet research, organizations, volunteer work, and any other.
- 10) Are all animals in your care in good health and current on medical treatment? If you practice holistic care, please provide details.
- 11) May we contact your vet? If yes, please include vet's name, phone number, and address. If no, please explain why.
- 12) What type of work do you do?
- 13) How many hours daily on average are you available to spend with the wolf dog?
- 14) What is your history of experience with animals? If you have never had a animal in your life, it will in no way rule you out as a potential home. We are seeking to make a complete profile in order to place the right animal with the right human. Some animals will require experience, while others are very adaptable and willing to train you, so please be honest and provide as much detail as possible. We would like to know how old you were when you acquired you first animal, what types of animals you have had, how long you had them, and when and why they left your care.

- 16) Do you have a preference as to the type of animal you wish to adopt, i.e. gender, color, and age?
- 17) What do you understand by the phrase, "establishing your alpha dominance" to mean?

- 18) Under what circumstances would it be appropriate to strike an animal?
- 19) Are you willing to accept this as a lifetime commitment?
- 20) Are you willing to work towards acquiring Fish and Wildlife permits? *If required.
It is not as difficult as you might have been lead to believe, and we are more than willing to help you.

- 22) Do you have a person who is able to care for this animal when you are away?
Most dog boarding facilities will not board wolf dogs, and even if they do, we personally do not recommend it due to the nature of the animals.
- 23) Are you expecting to train this animal for any particular type of work, i.e. protecting, search and rescue, personal assistance?
- 24) Are you able to adopt more than one animal? We often get two or more who have been rescued from the same home and are deeply bonded. We make every effort never to separate such animals.
- 25) Are you willing to work with an animal that has special rehabilitation requirements—physical, psychological, or both?
- 26) What are your personal interests and hobbies?
- 27) Have you ever been convicted of a felony? If yes, please provide details.
